- We have a register of approved property professionals, including solicitors, architects and surveyors, who assist with projects.
- We are an independent charity.

Charities that need property assistance

- Get in touch. Our advisors will discuss and offer a diagnostic response to the issue.
- Initial contact with the Foundation is free. Once an individual group's needs have been assessed, there may be some costs for longer term projects, but these will be discussed with an organisation prior to any work.
